PURPOSE This is the sixth year for the Big Press Scholarship. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to individuals enrolling in community colleges, colleges, trade schools and universities. The Big Press Scholarship principally targets two and four year academic programs; however, certificate/licensing programs including but not limited to fields such as paralegal training, IT, ultrasound techs, medical records personnel and nursing are also eligible.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE is based on financial need, academic performance, leadership potential, participation in The Big Press and community programs including but not limited to volunteer hours. Scholarships are awarded annually provided funds are available.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The Big Press committee awards scholarships on the basis of a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include, but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, Personal Essay and Financial Need. The Big Press committee pays scholarship funds directly to the recipient's school. The Big Press Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, gender. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must have permanent residence status in Arkansas.
- Applicants must be completing high school successfully with a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted as a full time student at a college, university, or trade school program for the
 upcoming academic semester. If scholarship money is awarded, this is the only program that will receive the
 funds on behalf of the applicant.
- Applicants must demonstrate a need for financial assistance.
- Applicants must be a current competitor or have competed in the Big Press.
- Applicants must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by Thursday, April 11th, 2019.
- Scholarship recipients will receive their check for the next semester only after their grades from the previous semester have been received.

TIMELINE

- Applications are due Thursday, April 11th, 2019.
- Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship on day of Big Press event.

Application Process

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed application form.
- Official high school transcript in a sealed envelope from the institution.
- Two academic references from a guidance counselor or teacher.
- A letter completed reference from a pastor or other community leader.
- Proof of acceptance at an academic, vocational or technical school for post-secondary studies.
- Demonstrated financial need.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- Award notification will be given the day of Big Press
- Applicant must provide their student ID, the correct mailing address of their institution and the department where their scholarship check is to be received.

CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

Deadline for the application is Thursday, **April 11th**, **2019**. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
